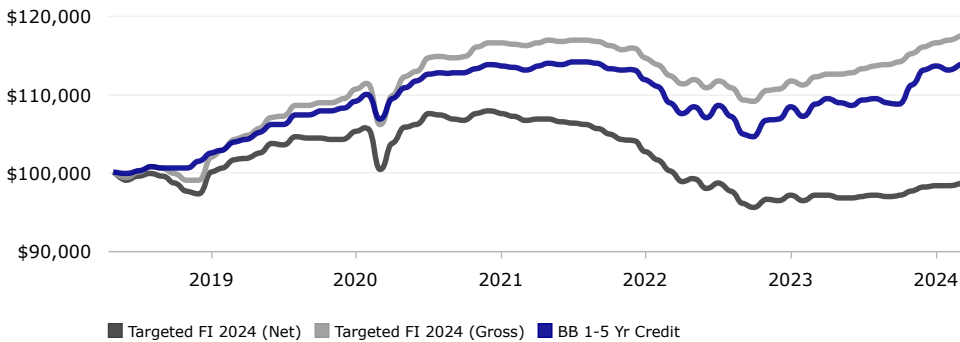
Risk Rating: Conservative Allocation

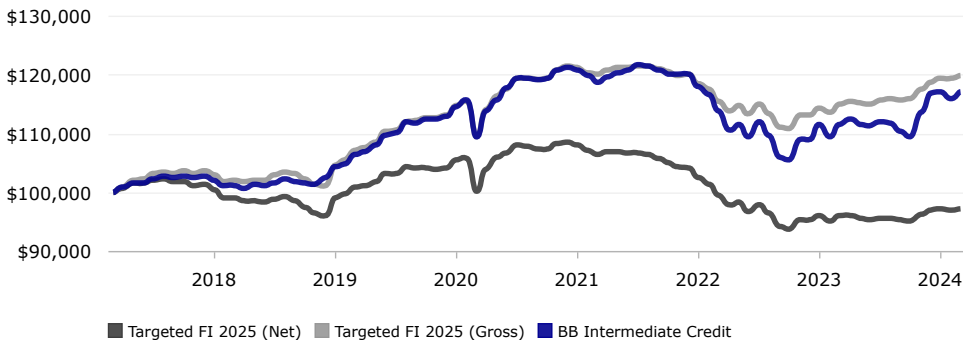

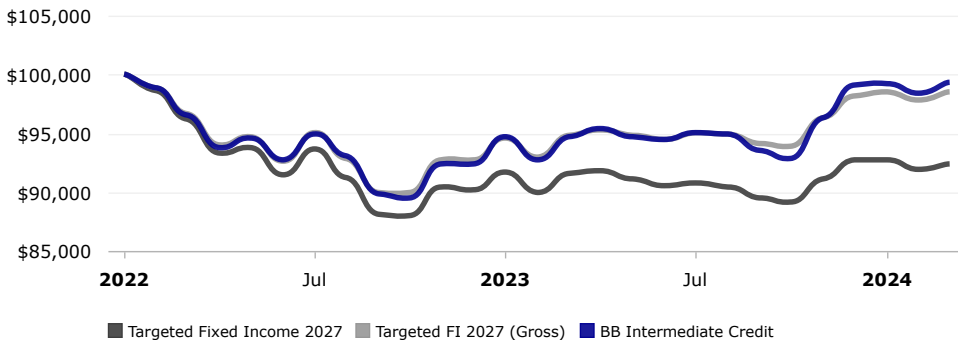
